a. *Why do we register our groups? Are we a 'Meeting' or a 'Group'?*

- *The goal with registration is connection. That every group gets a voice. The difference between the meeting and a group is a meeting is just a time and a place where as a group is something that exists outside of the meeting time. For example, if you have a GSR you have a group because they have service outside of the meeting time. H & I liaison, etc. Things that we track is name of group, what district and sub district it belongs to. For GSO purpose a hybrid meeting is considered a group. When groups register, they do it with a mail contact which can serve as a connection for the group.*
- *The city is where they should register with the district. Need their first meeting date. Three different paths with groups to register but the preferred one is with the district so that they can get immediately involved locally. It's all about connection.*
- *Groups are autonomous, so they can register with whatever district they want after a group conscious. Districts decide what their subdistricts are as well. If there's any change in boundaries as a whole that has to go to area, but most of those things are done internally. If you're adding a new subdistrict that has to go to area for approval, but mostly that is approved because we value autonomy.*
