#### Financials As of 12/31

We say goodbye to 2023 in a <u>Neutral</u> financial position. As indicated on the chart below we are closing the gap as our year to date Literature Expense has increased 37.7% over last year while our contributions have increased 18.4%. While definitely encouraging to see this gap becoming less each month and ending with cash on hand slightly above our recommended 6 months expenses, it is important to take a moment and look at our total year numbers.

In 2023 we had total contributions of \$467,152.37 after processing fees. Our literature expenses alone were \$471,399.05 exceeding our income, when other committee operating expenses were included, we ended the year with a negative \$60,669.07.

While it is not sustainable to operate at a loss. I believe if we continue to relate the necessity of passing the Pink Can to our fellowship to ensure a steady increase in contributions, it is possible that together we can continue to carry the message of AA and provide literature at the level we were able to in 2023.

We also need Men and Women Meeting Volunteers. Volunteer service will be on Sundays from 6-7pm. Archway would like to begin in Mid February.
